Just enter the information requested and press the "Subscribe" button. Our website has important community information including agendas, minutes, contacts, forms, ordinances and much more! We also post information on community events, water outages, and street projects.

2. **Sewer and Water Utility Payments.** The drop box near the entrance to Village Hall can be used for utility payments. If paying by check, please write your account number in the memo area. Online payments can be made from the Village Website, <https://villageoftheresa.com> using a debit or credit card. A nonrefundable service fee will be applied to all online payments. ***The process for depositing checks has changed and we will no longer accept post-dated checks. So, please be aware that if you give us a check we will not be "holding" it to deposit on a future date.***
 - **Pool Fill Credits Eliminated** – There will no longer be a sewer credit for the gallons used for filling pools.
 - **All water meters and technology will be upgraded in the near future.** This will allow unusual water usage to be noticed as it's happening instead of when meters are read at quarterly intervals. A smart phone app will also be available for individuals interested in monitoring water use. Updates will be posted on the website for this project.
3. **Village Hall Hours – Monday – Thursday 8 am – 4 pm, Friday 8 am – Noon. Feel free to use the drop box or mail your payments to Village of Theresa, PO Box 327, Theresa, WI 53091.** These hours may change in order to accommodate time off. Appointments before or after normal hours can be arranged by calling Village Hall.
4. **Attention Snow Birds and Summer Vacationers** – Please forward your mail through the Post Office. The Village of Theresa will no longer be sending utility and tax bills to addresses other than the primary addresses.

6. **Sewer Lateral Televising will continue throughout the Village.** The Department of Natural Resources is aware of infiltration from damaged laterals causing water to get into our sewer system. Property

owners will be invoiced for televising and if laterals are found to be in disrepair, the owner will have 3-years to repair the sewer lateral. Unpaid invoices will be a special assessment on property taxes.

7. **Winter Parking Restrictions.** Parking permits are needed to park on any "Village" side street between November 1 and April 1 annually. **There is NO overnight parking allowed on Milwaukee Street.** Permits can be obtained from the Village Website at <https://villageoftheresa.com> and the cost is \$35 per vehicle. **Failure to obtain a permit may cause citations to be issued.**
8. **Dog and Cat Reminder.** Tags and forms for 2022 will be available in mid-December. The cost is \$15 for each male/female and \$10 for neutered/spayed pets. All dogs and cats 5-months or older must be licensed annually. **A \$25 late fee will be assessed for each animal not licensed by March 31.** Please include a current rabies certificate for each pet and the exact payment amount by cash or check made payable to the Village of Theresa.
9. **Garbage and Recycling Pickup.** For concerns about Garbage and Recycling Pickup Issues please call 920-644-4640 or send an email to WMservice@wm.com or notify the Clerk-Treasurer. BULK PICKUP occurs on the 3rd Tuesday in April and October annually.
10. **Village Hall will be moving to 292 Mayville Street in late summer and will be in the same building as the Theresa Library** (separate entrances). **Exciting news ... there will be a drive-up drop box for payments and a meeting room with space for social distancing!**
